



ACI SDS NOTIFICATION

Advanced Composites Inc. manufactured composite structures pose no health or physical hazards. ACI products are inert “articles” as classified in OSHA’s Hazard Communication Standard.

Since ACI manufactured products are “articles,” they are exempt from SDS publishing requirements, as per Title 29, section 1910.1200c of the Code of Federal Regulations

(https://www.osha.gov/pls/oshaweb/owadisp.show_document?p_table=standards&p_id=10099):

Article means a manufactured item other than a fluid or particle: (i) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture; (ii) which has end use function(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use; and (iii) which under normal conditions of use does not release more than very small quantities, *e.g.*, minute or trace amounts of a hazardous chemical (as determined under paragraph (d) of this section), and does not pose a physical hazard or health risk to employees.

Any post-processing of ACI manufactured composites structures, such as machining, sanding, cutting or the like, necessitates proper respiratory, eye and skin protection. In addition to proper PPE, ACI recommends dust mitigation at the source via use of dust collection devices and/or cutting fluid.

Exposing ACI composite products to excessive heat could cause VOCs or other compounds to be emitted.
